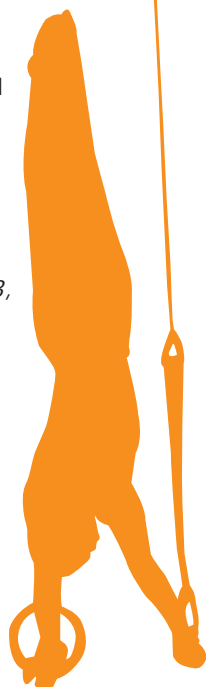

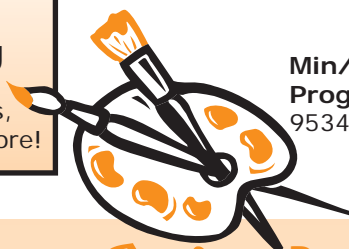

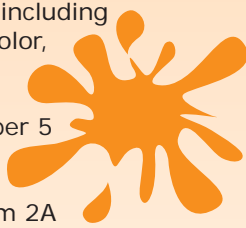


Visual arts
