



# REGISTER NOW FOR SUMMER CAMPS!

Registration for camps begins February 1 and is for RESIDENTS ONLY. Non-resident registration for camps begins April 27.

## CAMP INFORMATION

### Day Camp, Kids Camp, and Sports Camp

A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit per session will hold your child's spot in Day Camp, Kids Camp, or Sports Camp for Session I through IV. Included in the full payment is the \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit per session, per child. Session V must be paid in full. The 9 week Day Camp deposit is \$193. Deposit for 9 week Parkside Kids Camp is \$210. Deposit for 8 week Birchwood Kids Camp and Birchwood Day Camp is \$100. You will receive your bill in the mail and payment must be paid in full by the due date to guarantee registration. Please save the top portion of your bill for your flexible spending accounts and tax purposes. **If your payment is not received by the due date, camp space will be offered to the wait list patrons.** If your child has a spot in camp, extended hours and the lunch program will be available for all sites of Day Camp, Kids Camp, and Sports Camp. Registration for extended hours and the lunch program will be in the summer catalog.

**Online registration will be available to participants who pay in full.**

**Refunds:** Our refund policy is 100%, minus the camp deposit, up to 10 days before camp starts and 50%, minus the camp deposit, after the second day of camp. Included in the full payment is the \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit, per session, per person. Medical refunds are subject to review. Refunds for anything paid by VISA, MASTERCARD, or DISCOVER will be processed directly through your charge account. No refunds after June 16 for the 8 and 9 week camp.

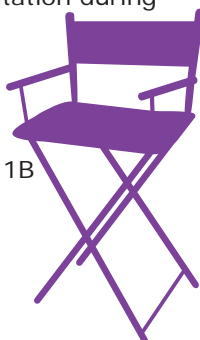

### A Theater Immersion Workshop

This program is designed for the young singer/actor/dancer looking for an immersion experience in the world of musical theater. Don't be afraid if you are not trained in all three areas. We will teach you if you are willing to learn. Every participant will be assigned a role in the show appropriate for his/her level of development/experience. Assigned roles are based upon a prepared vocal audition, as well as movement and script reading auditions which will be taught on the first day.
