

Palatine Park District Freedom of Information Act Required Postings

The Palatine Park District is a separate municipal governmental agency established for the purpose of providing parks, recreational facilities and leisure programs for its residents. The Park District is responsible for the maintenance, operation and administration of parks and park facilities under its jurisdiction.

The Administrative Offices of the Park District are located on the second floor of the Community Center, 250 E. Wood Street, Palatine, IL, 60067-5358.

Functional subdivisions of the Palatine Park District are: Board of Park Commissioners, Executive Director, Finance & Personnel Department, Parks & Planning Department, Recreation Department and Revenue Facilities Department.

During 2010, the Park District will employ 75 full-time employees and approximately 1,000 part-time and seasonal employees. Budgeted revenues are \$18,800,000 and budgeted expenses are \$26,600,000 for 2010. Operating funds are Corporate, Recreation, Insurance, Audit, Bond & Interest, Museum, Handicapped Recreation, Pools, Acquisition & Improvement, Gold Course, Retirement and Stables.

The Board of Park Commissioners is elected in at-large elections for six-year terms. The membership of the Board presently consists of Susan E. Gould (President), Jennifer Rogers (Vice-President), Nicholas G. Sawyer (Treasurer), John F. Cozza and Andrew S. McPherson.

Currently there are no commissioners, committees or councils which operate in a formal advisory capacity to the Board or which exercise control over its policies or procedures, or to which the Park District is required to report and be answerable for its operations.
